Intercessory Prayer (Wednesdays @ 6:30 PM; Room 100)

Seeking God' face and interceding for the needs of our families, our church, our community, and our world.

"The First Three" Days of Prayer & Fasting (First 3 day of each month)

Fasting is consciously choosing to deprive yourself of food, or denying yourself the satisfaction of a natural desire (TV, pop, internet, etc.) When should we fast?

- When facing mammoth tasks or challenges (Nehemiah 1:4)
- When you are in danger/under attack (Esther; 2 Chronicles 20; Mark 9:25-29)
- When you are appalled at wickedness and evil behavior
- When Holy Spirit prompts you to fast (John 16:13-15)
- When Spiritual Leaders call for a time of fasting (Joel 2:15; Ezra 8:21; 2 Chron. 20:3)
- During times of transition

We encourage you to set aside specific times of prayer and fasting during these three days.

Prayer & Worship Encounter (3rd of each month)

What you can expect at the Prayer & Worship Encounter:

- We will come with the intent of ministering to God in worship and prayer.
- There will be time for **personal worship and prayer** and there will be time when we **come together and pray in agreement** for the areas of need revealed by Holy Spirit.
- We will pray in the Spirit and in understanding. We will listen to what God has for us.
